Economic growth

East Africa is set to lead Africa with growth rates projected at 5.1% in 2024 and 5.7% in 2025.²



Power expansion

The power market in East Africa is projected to grow at a CAGR of over 3% from 2021 to 2026.³



Population expansion

The East African Community's population is expected to grow by 5.3% in 2024 and 5.8% in 2025-26, the fastest growth in the continent.³



Water demand

Water demand in Sub-Saharan Africa is expected to rise by 283% over 2005 levels by 2030.⁶



Tourism boost

Tourist arrivals are forecasted to double from 7 million to over 14 million by 2025, aided by a Single Tourism Visa and new multi-destination packages.⁴



Waste management

Waste generation in Dar es Salaam, Nairobi and Kampala is projected to increase by nearly 60% and 74% respectively by 2030, with daily per capita waste at 1.970 kg, 0.845 kg and 1.150 kg.⁷

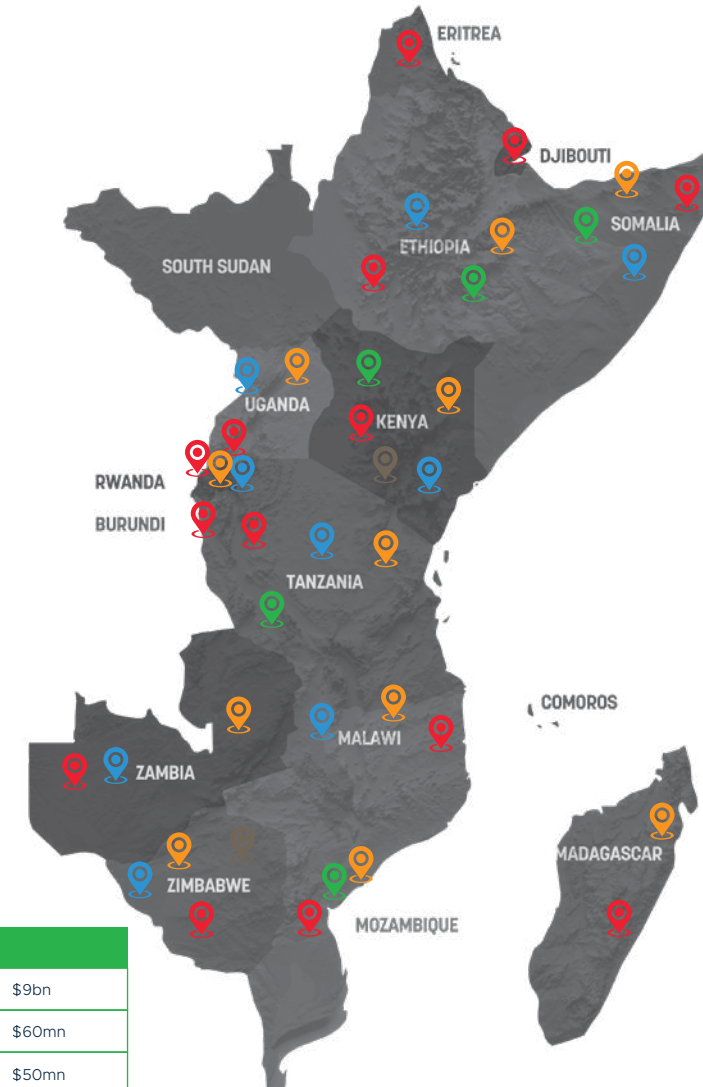

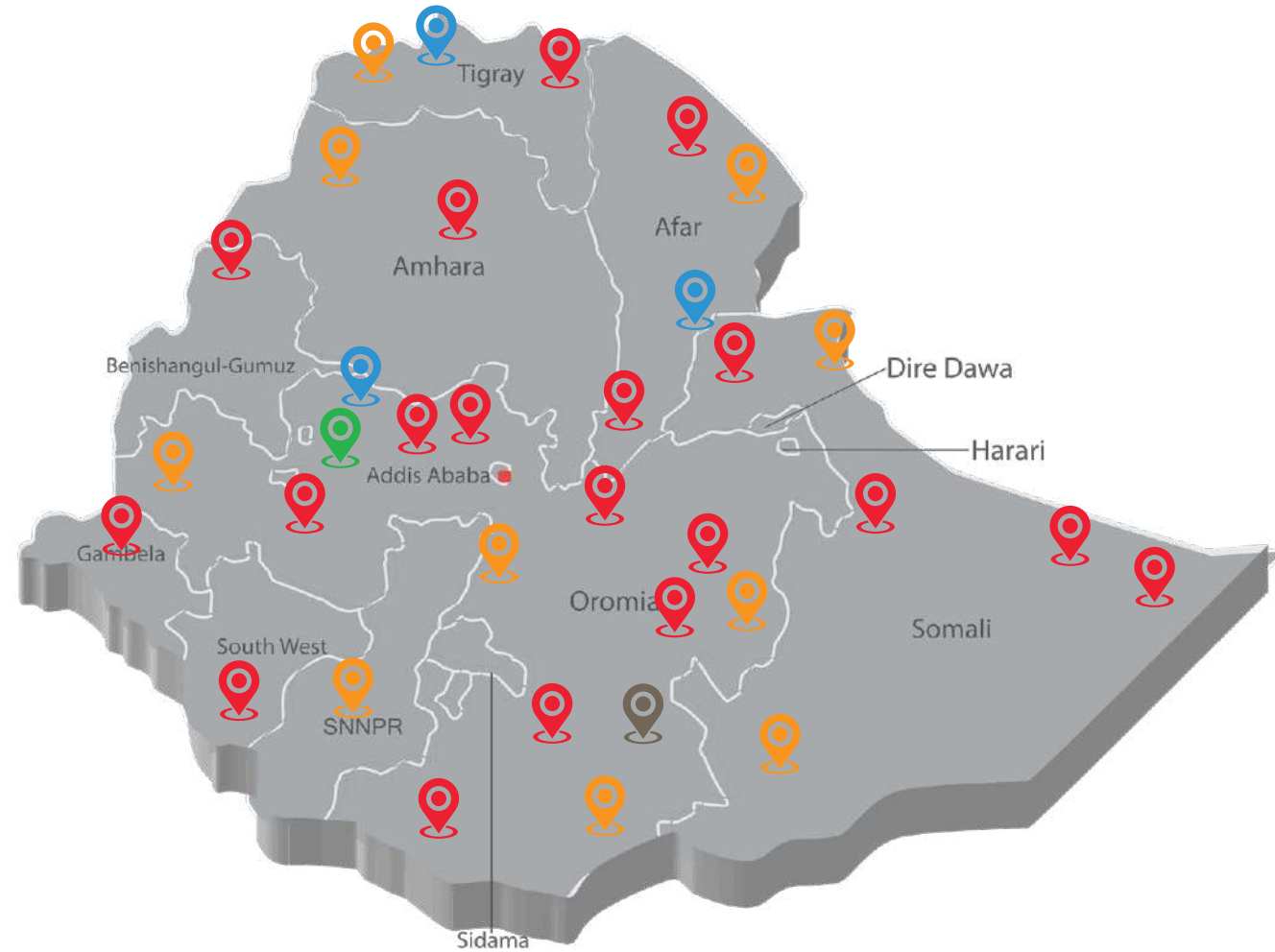
